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# Railway transport



## **Railway section** "Elin Pelin – Kostenetz"

In 2020, the contracts for the implementation of the three separate positions under the project "Modernization of the railway line Sofia - Plovdiv: railway section Elin Pelin - Kostenetz" were concluded and the design is underway.

With the fifth amendment of OPTTI, it is envisaged that part of the project will be implemented with funds under the current Programme, respectively the other activities will be completed under the Programme "Transport Connectivity" 2021 - 2027.

"Plovdiv – Burgas, Phase 2"

In 2020, the Skutare-Orizovo section was officially put into operation. The railway and contact network in the area, the signalling and telecommunication systems, the reception and technical buildings of railway stations "Belozem" and "Manole" are rehabilitated. A pavilion has been built, the railway stop "Opulchenetz" has been rehabilitated with guaranteed access for persons with reduced mobility.

All major contracts under the project have been concluded and it is planned to complete their activities by the end of 2023. Within the project, the implementation of 24 road overpasses / underpasses is to be assigned.

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# Railway transport (railway stations)



Significant progress in 2020 in the reconstruction of the railway station complexes - **Iskar, Poduyane, Kazichene and Karnobat**.

reconstructed station The complex Poduyane was opened on 22.12.2020. Within the decorative the project elements of the facade, the ornaments on the walls in the waiting room were restored, and their authenticity is completely preserved. The pavilion built into the waiting room, which is emblematic of the building, has been preserved also and renewed.





**Karnobat station complex** is 99% complete. During the renovation, the reception building was completely renovated, new energy efficient and high-tech modern installations were built electrical, heating, ventilation, air conditioning, plumbing, security, video surveillance, public address system.



98% of the planned activities have been completed for **Kazichene railway station**, 75% for **Iskar railway station**, 15% for **Stara Zagora railway station**.

In 2020, the contract for the implementation of the reconstruction of the **Nova Zagora station complex** was signed.





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## Road transport









## **STRUMA Motorway**

**"Zheleznitsa"** is the longest road tunnel ever built in Bulgaria. It has two separate pipes for movement in the direction and the length of each is about 2 km.

The tunnel is being built using a **new Austrian method**. The construction activities started in October 2019 and people on the site have been working without interruption. At the end of 2020, over 50% of the activities have been completed.

**The viaduct**, which is located before "Zheleznitsa", in the direction from Sofia to Kulata, is being built using the **"push-pull" technology**. In 2020, the pushing of the road to Sofia was completed.

**The bridge** crosses over 6 obstacles - the Struma River, road E79, the existing and the future railway line, the municipal road and the service road of the tunnel.









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#### MS "Krasno selo"







**8 km of metro lines and 8 metro stations** under the project for the central section from "Zhitnitsa" Street to "Vladimir Vazov" Blvd. were put into operation in **August 2020**. For the first time in the country, **automatic platform partition doors** have been introduced.

Metro – Stage I

**The passengers of the new 8 stations** in perspective will be about **60,000 per day**, and the travel time from MS "Krasno Selo" to the center is about **7 minutes**.

The **20 new metro trains** financed under OPTTI have been delivered to the **newly built metro depot "Zemlyane"** and will serve the entire Line 3 of the metro. The trains are the **latest generation** and have an option for **automatic control without a driver**.

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## Metro – Stage II



The works for the finalization of Stage II - section "st. Zhitnitsa r.c. Ovcha Kupel - Ring Road" on Line 3 continues. The site will be put into operation by the end of April 2021, after successful completion of the necessary tests and trials.

With the launch of **Stage II**, the metro in Sofia will connect not only the neighborhoods of Gorna Banya and Ovcha Kupel with the city center, but also those traveling on the railway route "Sofia-Pernik-Kulata".

Estimates show that with **the new 4 stations**, the metro will initially carry about 25-30,000 passengers, and in the future their number will increase to **45,000 passengers a day**.

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# Water transport - management and service innovations





## Executive Agency For Exploration and Maintenance of The Danube River

Under the project for improvement of navigation on the Danube River, part of the dredging equipment was delivered, as well as the contracts for supply of a specialized dredging vessel for carrying out this activity were signed by IAPPD.



## **Bulgarian Ports Infrastructure Company**

In 2020, the implementation of the VTMIS-4 project was successfully completed and permits for use were issued for all 22 sites in its scope. The Information Centers in Varna and Burgas provide faster information services to the ports by improving the organization of document processing.



## Executive Agency "Maritime Administration"

In 2020, the study for the implementation of an integrated information system in case of disasters and accidents in the Bulgarian maritime region was completed, which prepared all the necessary documents for the development and implementation of the system.







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## Sociological survey



**In 2020, the second wave of a nationally representative sociological survey** took place. The aim was to collect up-to-date data on the visibility and approval of OPTTI, the expected benefits of the program projects, as well as the most appropriate communication channels.

The data showed that OPTTI is the operational Programme in Bulgaria, that is known from the biggest share of the Bulgarian citizens, aged 15 + years - 44.3%.



Among them, 92% approve the Programme and consider its projects as some of the most important European projects implemented in the country.
