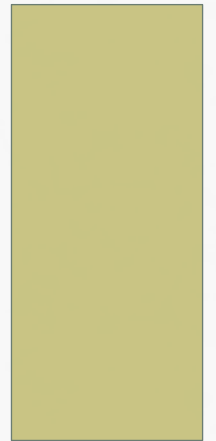

- **IT IS NOT AN OBLIGATION**

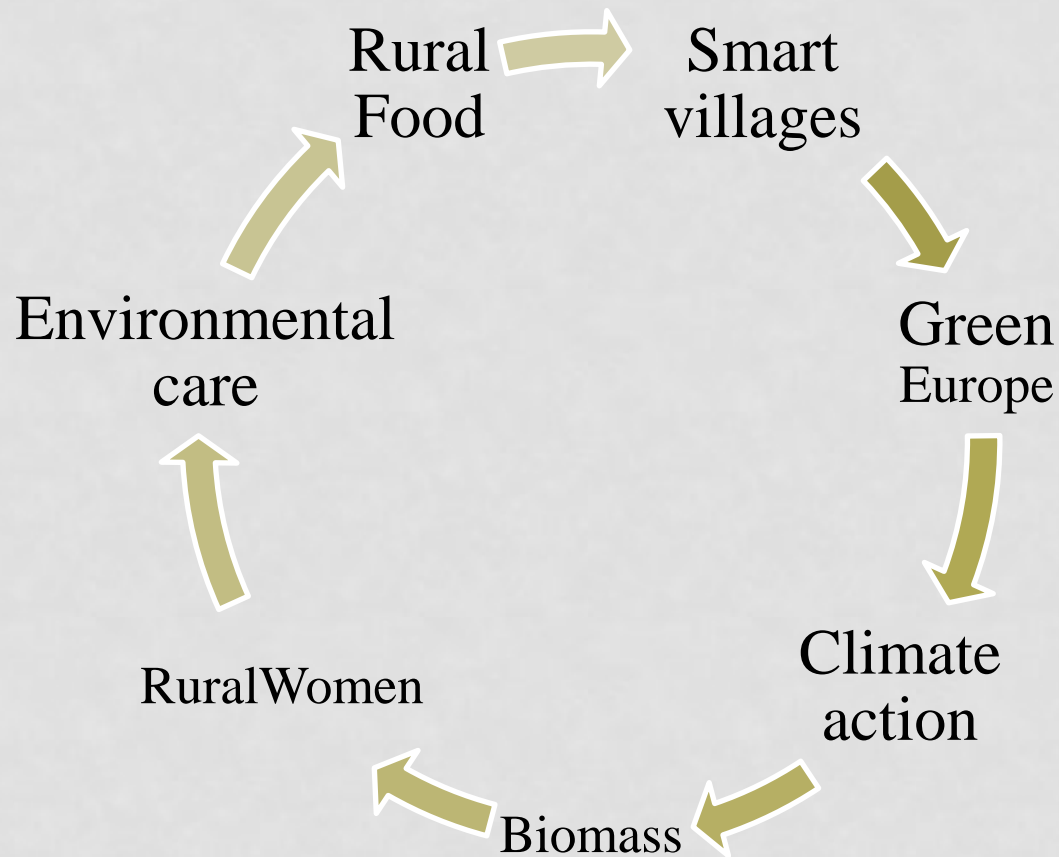

- How appropriate is the timing to launch such a project?

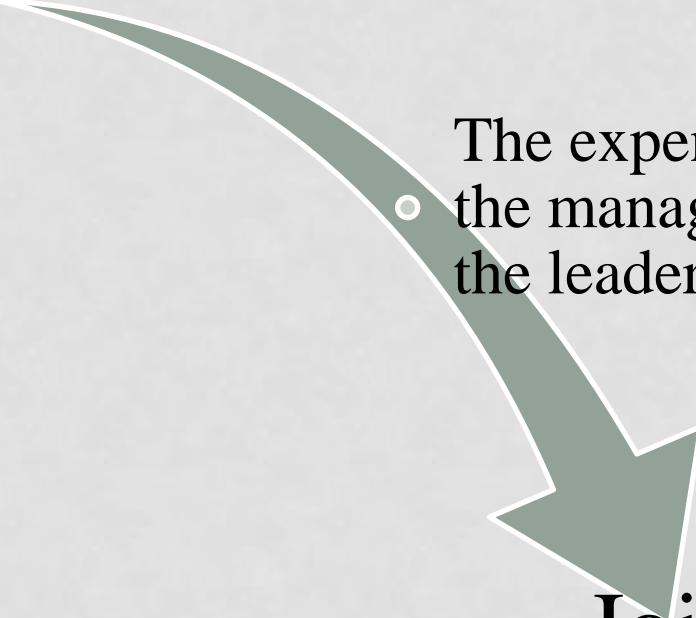

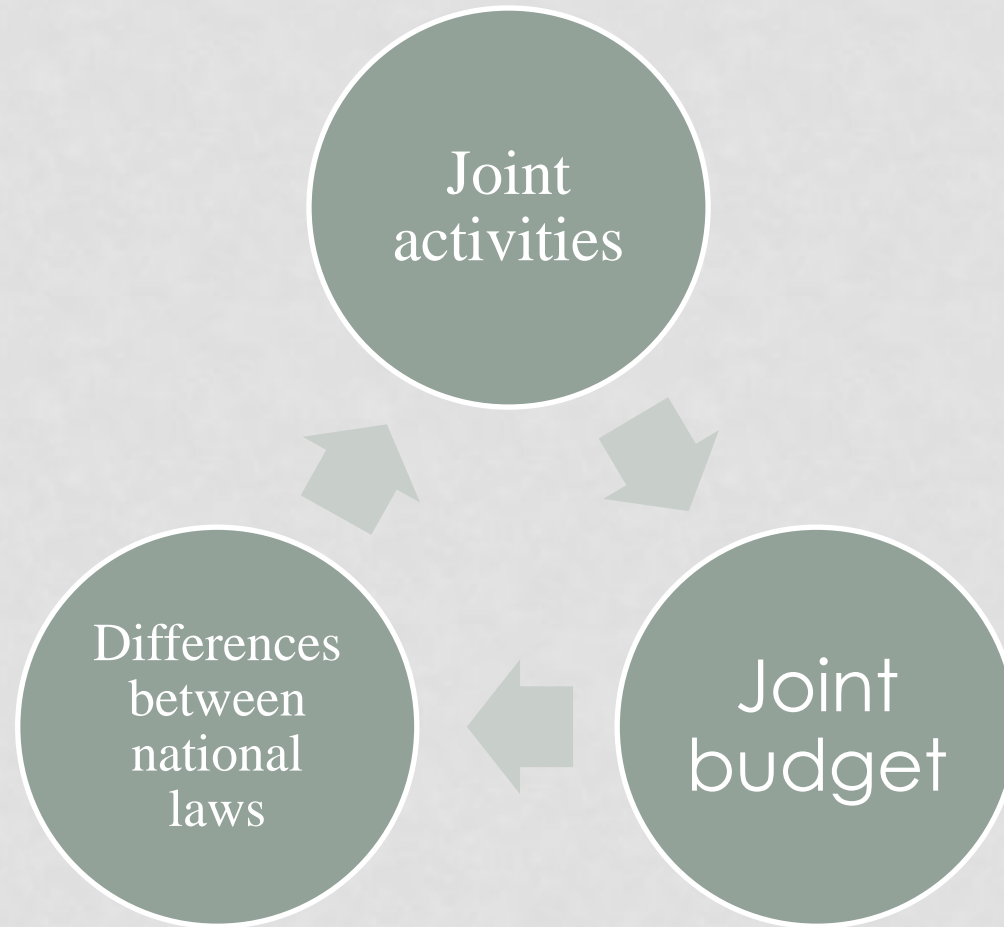
